Grand Prize Winners

Repertoire Selections - 2025

Qualifications & Application Process

Each category requires 3 separate pieces. Accompaniment where appropriate is suggested, but not required.

Clarinet, Classical

- Augusta Holmès: Fantaisie for Clarinet and Piano
- Paquito D'Rivera: Three pieces for Clarinet and Piano (I. Contradanza, II. Habanera, III. Vals Venezolano – Upload each piece as a separate track)
- A single contrasting work of applicant's choice not to exceed 15 minutes

Saxophone, Classical

- Claude Pascal: Sonatine for Alto Saxophone and Piano
- Evan Williams: Rock Steady for Alto Saxophone
- A single contrasting work of applicant's choice not to exceed 15 minutes

Jazz, Clarinet or Saxophone

Repertoire to include one ballad, one medium tempo, and one up tempo song.

Ballad (choose one)

 Darn That Dream, God Bless the Child, Skylark, Warm Valley (Ellington), You're My Everything

Medium tempo

• Afternoon in Paris, Beautiful Love, I've Never Been In Love Before, Lady Bird, Pennies From Heaven

Up tempo (choose one)

• Download Troy Roberts' etude "Madonna Leigh". Charts are available for Eb and Bb.
Play 4 choruses: Etude melody 1 chorus, 2 choruses improvised solo (over the chord changes to 'Donna Lee' in concert Ab) and play the etude melody to finish. Tempo should be between 230 and 250 bpm. Use of accompaniment is encouraged.
